Please be informed that:

1.- Kilian's Leichnam (corpse) can be visited Wednesday and Thursday, May 20 and 21, at the small Chapel in Kilchberg's cemetery.

Opening hours are from 9 AM through 4 PM.

2.- There will be a short Christian ceremony on Friday, May 22, at 14.30 PM at the Chapel.

The ceremony will be led by Pfarrer Josef-Michael Karber from beautiful Liebfrauenkirche in Zürich.

Over the years, Kilian did develop a particular affinity with the Liebfrauenkirche. And we suspect that during his ETH years he went regularly there as well.

He certainly did, many times, when coming from Pully to USZ for treatment.

3.- Kilian's Sarg (coffin) will then be carried by some family members and friends to our family-grave - just a few minutes away from the Chapel.

We may have another short praying, and the burial into his resting place will be carried-out.

4.- Everyone is welcome to attend and participate. No particular dress-code.

Circumstances are certainly very sad.

And yet, celebrating Kilian's extraordinary life and saying farewell together shall be (and be remembered) as a happy event.

Tears and smiles are allowed. No limits.

5.- There is no follow-up gathering.

6.- We trust that there will be as much "social distancing" as required for mutual and reciprocal respect. Thank you.

7.- Finally, we expect that a more formal Mass on Kilian's memory and honor will take place at Liebfrauenkirche sometime in September - i.e., once larger gatherings are more normal again.
